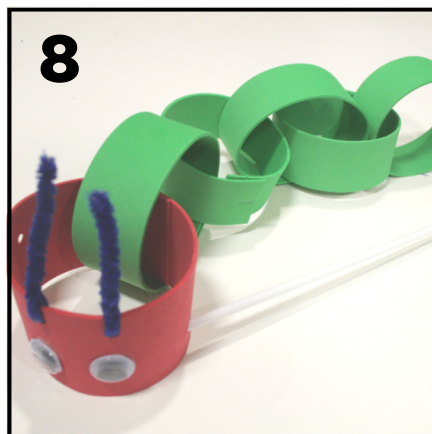
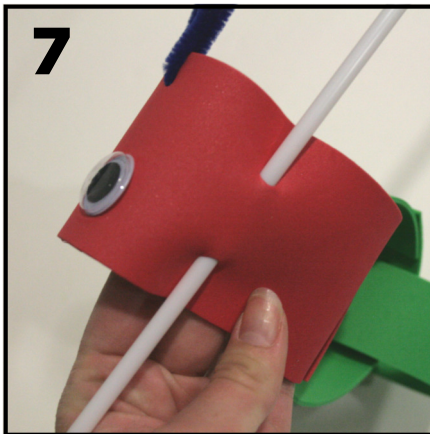
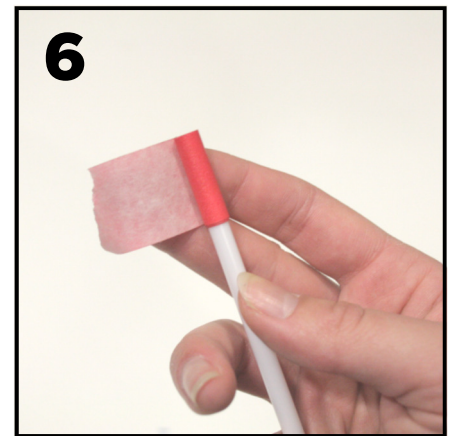
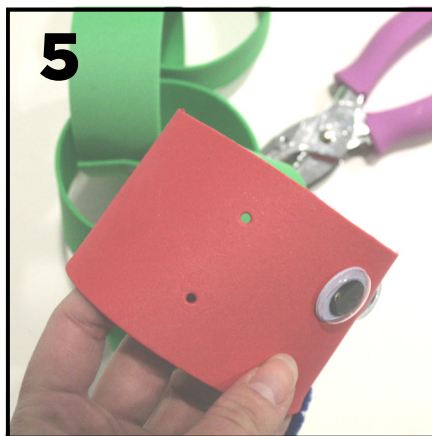
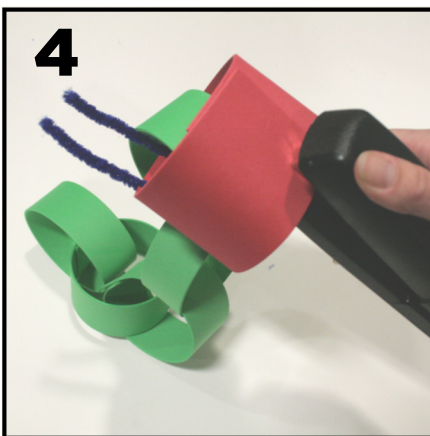
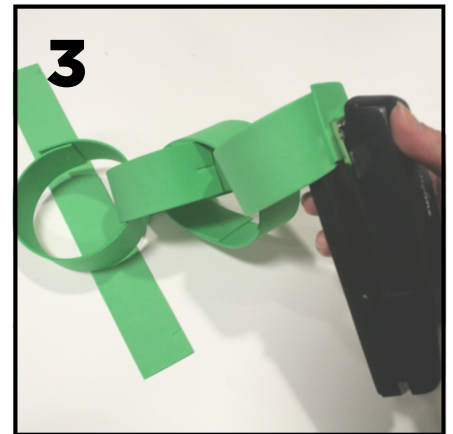
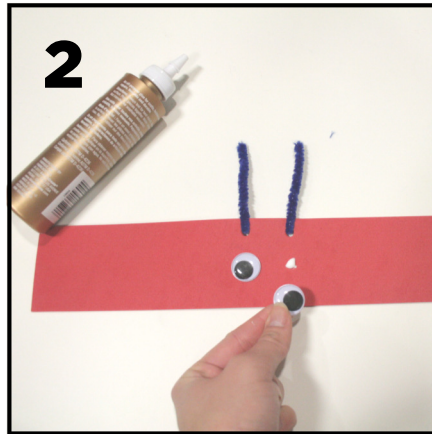
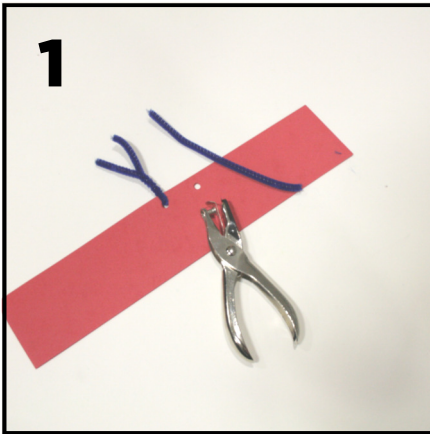


HOW TO MAKE A CATERPILLAR PUPPET



BEFORE YOU START, PICK UP:

- 5 Green Foam Strips
- 1 Red Foam Strip
- 2 Purple Pipe Cleaners
- Plastic stick

1. In the center of your red foam strip, punch two holes on the top for your antennae. Insert one pipe cleaner through a hole and twist the ends together. Repeat with the second pipe cleaner.
2. Glue two eyes below your purple antennae.
3. While the eyes are drying, loop a green foam strip and staple together. Loop another strip through your ring and repeat to create a chain.
4. Loop the caterpillar face and staple to complete the chain.
5. Punch two holes on the top and bottom of the red foam near your caterpillar's eyes.
6. Tear a 4 inch strip of tape and wrap around one end of your plastic stick.
7. Starting with the untaped end, weave the plastic stick through the top towards the center of the red loop, and then out through the bottom hole.
8. Now you have a caterpillar puppet!
