

## 2023 JIMMY AWARDS CURRENT TIMELINE FOR COVID-19 VACCINATION

This information is based on [current CDC guidelines](#) and what we currently anticipate the COVID-19 vaccination requirements will be for participation in The Jimmy Awards. These guidelines should not be construed as medical advice. Instead, they simply serve as a starting point for students considering auditioning for The Jimmy Awards to assess any necessary action they need to take and when in order to be Jimmy Awards eligible.

These date calculations are based on the interpretation that “fully vaccinated” is two weeks after the final dose of a primary vaccine series.\*

**Pfizer** – two dose primary series, with 3-8 weeks recommended between first and second dose.

*Cut-Off Dates:*

- Series initiated no later than May 14, 2023
- Second dose administered by June 4, 2023 (two weeks prior to Jimmy Awards check-in)

**Moderna** – two dose primary series, with 4-8 weeks recommended between first and second dose.

*Cut-Off Dates:*

- Series initiated no later than May 7, 2023
- Second dose administered by June 4, 2023 (two weeks prior to Jimmy Awards check-in)

**Novavax** two dose primary series, with 3-8 weeks recommended between first and second dose.

*Cut-Off Dates:*

- Series initiated no later than May 14, 2023
- Second dose administered by June 4, 2023 (two weeks prior to Jimmy Awards check-in)

**J&J/Janssen** – single dose primary series. FDA approval for individuals 18 years old and up only.

*Cut-Off Dates:*

- Single dose received no later than June 4, 2023 (two weeks prior to Jimmy Awards check-in)

\*We are still awaiting guidelines on whether the host university will require up-to-date boosters for any student who is booster-eligible.
